4. Title: School attendance officers; petitions for violation of school attendance order

5. Summary: Provides that an attendance officer, or a division superintendent or his designee when acting as an attendance officer pursuant to §22.1-258, may complete, sign, and file with the intake officer of the juvenile and domestic relations district court, on forms approved by the Supreme Court of Virginia, a petition for a violation of a school attendance order in response to the filing of a petition alleging the pupil is a child in need of supervision as defined in §16.1-228.
