- 3. Committee: Education and Health
- **4. Title:** Public schools; possession of undesignated stock albuterol inhalers; administration by certain individuals.
- **5. Summary:** The bill limits the liability of (i) any such individual who provides, administers, or assists in the administration of an albuterol inhaler for a student believed in good faith to be in need of such medication and (ii) the prescriber of such medication. The bill also provides that a prescriber may authorize pursuant to a written order or standing protocol issued within the course of the prescriber's professional practice an employee of (i) a school board, (ii) a school for students with disabilities, or (iii) an accredited private school who is trained in the administration or supervision of self-administered inhaled asthma medications to administer or supervise the self-administration of such medication to a student diagnosed with a condition requiring inhaled asthma medications when the student is believed to be experiencing or about to experience an asthmatic crisis.
