- **4. Title:** Public institutions of higher education; in-state tuition; refugees.
- 5. Summary: Provides that an individual is eligible for in-state tuition charges regardless of domicile if he is admitted to the United States as a refugee under 8 U.S.C. § 1157 or has a Special Immigrant Visa that has been granted a status under P.L. 110-181 § 1244, P.L. 109-163 § 1059, or P.L. 111-8 § 602, and upon entering the United States, the individual resided in the Commonwealth and continues to reside in the Commonwealth.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: This bill could allow for certain students to become eligible for in-state tuition who currently pay the out-of-state rate, and would constitute a loss of revenue equal to the difference between the two for institutions where such students are enrolled. The number of students who would be affected is indeterminate.
