3. Committee: Passed both houses

4. Title: Public institutions of higher education; students; determination of domicile.

5. Summary: Prohibits any student at a public institution of higher education from being deemed ineligible to establish domicile and receive in-state tuition charges solely on the basis of the immigration status of his parent.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: No fiscal impact is expected because the provisions of this legislation are presently part of the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia's (SCHEV) guidelines on determining domicile. Because these guidelines are not legally binding, however, a public institution of higher education could deviate from them. This legislation would codify this element of the guidelines, prohibiting institutions from deviating from this policy. The number of students who would be affected is indeterminate and the degree of participation by public institutions is not known; therefore, any actual impact is indeterminate.
