4. Title: Sale of wildlife mounts permitted.

5. Summary: This bill exempts from the prohibition against selling wild animals any Virginia resident selling a wildlife or fish mount that was taken legally and that underwent the taxidermy process legally.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF) anticipates that this bill will result in a nominal fiscal impact. DGIF indicates that, pursuant to the provisions of § 29.1-553, Code of Virginia, there have been a total of 58 offenses over the last four years with an average penalty of \$200.
