4. Title: The University of Mary Washington, Radford University, and Virginia State University.

5. Summary: Permits the University of Mary Washington, Radford University, and Virginia State University to deem eligible for in-state tuition any enrolled student, regardless of domicile.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary, see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill could allow for students to become eligible for in-state tuition who currently pay the higher out-of-state rate. Although this could lead to a loss of revenue to these institutions equal to the difference between the two rates at each institution. At this time, it is not possible to determine what the revenue implications to these institutions might be. It could potentially increase the number the students attending these institutions.
