3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Dispensing cannabidiol oil and THC-A oil; non-Virginia residents.

5. Summary: Removes the requirement that a person be a Virginia resident to obtain a certification for cannabidiol oil and THC-A oil in Virginia. The bill requires pharmaceutical processors to dispense cannabidiol oil and THC-A oil to patients, located in Virginia, pursuant to a valid written certification issued by a Virginia practitioner.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate, see item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact this bill would have on the Commonwealth cannot be determined. It is unknown how many patients, located in Virginia, would seek cannabidiol oil or THC-A oil. Therefore, any increase in workload for new registrants is indeterminate.
