4. Title: Appointed school boards; members; salaries.

5. Summary: Eliminates the annual salary limits for appointed school board members and permits any appointed school board to pay each of its members an annual salary that is consistent with the salary procedures and no more than the salary limits provided for local governments in Article 1.1 (§ 15.2-1414.1 et seq.) of Chapter 14 of Title 15.2 (Counties, Cities and Towns) or as provided by charter.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: There is no immediate state fiscal impact resulting from the provisions of this bill. Over time, salary increases at the local level could increase the prevailing costs used in the Standards of Quality funding model. Any actual fiscal impact at the state and local levels is indeterminate.
