**2. Patron:** Brewer

**3. Committee:** Passed Both Houses

**4. Title:** Department of Transportation; primary evacuation routes.

**5. Summary:** Directs the Virginia Department of Transportation (the Department), in consultation with the Department of Emergency Management, to develop, maintain, and make publicly available a map of primary evacuation routes in the Commonwealth. The bill requires the Department to review the transportation infrastructure along such routes and submit a report with such findings and any recommended improvements to the General Assembly at least once every five years.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final. See item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The number of primary evacuation routes throughout the Commonwealth is currently unknown. As a result, the costs associated with developing and publishing a map, reviewing infrastructure along the routes, and reporting on findings and recommendations are indeterminate.

This legislation is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact to the Department of Emergency Management.
