3. Committee: Passed both Houses.

4. Title: Virginia Charitable Gaming Board; regulations of the Board; electronic or mechanical equipment.

5. Summary: Provides that no more than 18 devices that facilitate the play of electronic versions of instant bingo, pull tabs or seal cards, commonly referred to as electronic pull tabs, may be used upon the premises owned or exclusively leased by the organization and at such times as the portion of the premises in which the instant bingo, pull tabs or seal cards are sold is open only to members and their guests. Currently, a limit of nine electronic pull tabs may be placed in the social quarters of a qualified organization as provided by Virginia Charitable Gaming Board regulations.
