4. Title: Judicial assistants

5. Summary: The substitute bill provides that an employee hired and paid by a county or city to assist with the administration of a judge's office in the twenty-seventh, twenty-eighth, twenty-ninth, or thirtieth judicial circuits serves at the sole direction and under the sole supervision of such judge. The bill further notes that nothing in the bill affects the authority of the circuit court clerk to (i) perform statutory duties with respect to court administration or (ii) assign deputy clerks to provide judicial assistance to the court, at the sole discretion of the clerk.
