**4. Title:** School principals; incident reports.

**5. Summary:** Eliminates the requirement for school principals to report to the local law-enforcement agency certain acts enumerated that constitute a misdemeanor offense. Requires that when the principal reports any act to the parents of any minor student, the principal shall report whether the incident has been reported to local law enforcement.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal Implications:** There is no anticipated state fiscal impact resulting from the provisions of this bill. Any fiscal impact to local school divisions is indeterminate.
