4. Title: Furloughs from local work release programs; approval by local sheriff and local chief.

Summary: The enrolled bill requires that if an offender is participating in a work release program under the supervision of the administrator of a regional jail and the furlough would extend the limits of confinement of the offender to a locality not served by that regional jail, then notice of the furlough must be provided to the sheriff of such locality.
