**4. Title:** Department of General Services; public posting of contract information on central electronic procurement.

**5. Summary:** Provides for the Department of General Services to post on its central electronic procurement system awarded contracts and any modifications to such contracts. The bill also provides that any contract awarded pursuant to an Invitation to Bid or Request for Proposals on or after July 1, 2021, including any subsequent modifications to the contract by a using agency as defined in § 2.2-1110, shall be posted on the Department of General Services' central electronic procurement system. Additionally, a modification made by a using agency on or after July 1, 2021, to any other contract with two or more years remaining awarded before that date shall be posted on the Department of General Services' central electronic procurement system, along with the original contract and any previous modifications.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No state fiscal impact.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of General Services indicates that this bill does not generate a fiscal impact.
