4. Title: Minimum wage; tipped employees, classification.

5. Summary: This bill prohibits an employer from classifying an individual as a tipped employee if the individual is prohibited by applicable federal or state law or regulation from soliciting tips.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Labor and Industry has indicated that this bill may result in a nominal workload impact, which the agency anticipates being able to absorb, as under current law, most minimum wage cases are investigated by the U.S. Department of Labor.
