**4. Title:** Smoking in motor vehicle with a minor present.

**5. Summary:** Expands the group in the presence of whom it is illegal to smoke in a motor vehicle from minors under the age of eight to minors under the age of 15.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The proposed legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact on state agencies. Although existing law establishes that a violation of this section is punishable by a civil penalty of \$100, which is deposited into the Literary Fund, the proceeds that may be generated as a result of this bill are indeterminate.
