3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Hospitals; notification; physical therapy.

5. Summary: Requires each hospital that provides services to a patient who may require physical therapy following discharge to provide to the patient at the time the service is scheduled (i) notice that physical therapy may be required following discharge and that, in cases in which physical therapy is required following discharge, the patient will be required to select a physical therapy provider at the time of discharge and (ii) a list of physical therapists to which the hospital may refer patients.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill, as amended, would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The provisions of the bill would require the Board of Health to promulgate regulations, however this will not impact the agency or its operations.
