- 3. Committee: Commerce and Labor
- **4. Title:** Employment; disclosure of terms.
- **5. Summary:** This bill requires every employer to furnish to its employees, at the time of the employee's hiring, a written disclosure of information regarding the terms of employment, including the name and address of the employer, the rate of pay and basis thereof, and the regular payday. The measure also requires employers to notify its employees in writing of any changes to this information.

As amended, this bill defines "employee" and establishes exceptions for the designation.
