4. Title: Stormwater management; proprietary best management practices; reciprocity.

Summary: Directs the State Water Control Board to adopt regulations providing for the use of a proprietary best management practice only if another state, regional, or national certification program has verified and certified its nutrient or sediment removal effectiveness, and for the evaluation and potential inclusion of nonproprietary stormwater control technologies.
