4. Title: Institutions of higher education; sexual violence policies; immunity from disciplinary action.

5. Summary: Requires the governing board of each nonprofit private institution of higher education and each public institution of higher education except the Virginia Military Institute to include as part of its policy, code, rules, or set of standards governing sexual violence a provision for immunity from disciplinary action based on personal consumption of drugs or alcohol where such disclosure is made in conjunction with a good faith report of an act of sexual violence..

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill will require updates to sexual violence policies, but no fiscal impact is expected due to this requirement.
