3. Committee: House Committee on General Laws

4. Title: Interdiction prohibiting the sale of alcoholic beverages

5. Summary: The substitute bill removes persons who have shown themselves to be habitual drunkards from the statutes that (i) allow the court to enter an order of interdiction prohibiting the sale of alcoholic beverages to such person, and (ii) list the disqualifications for a concealed handgun permit.
