**4. Title:** Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation; natural gas automobile mechanics; removal of certification requirement.

**5. Summary:** Removes the certification requirement for, and associated regulatory authority over, the occupation of natural gas automobile mechanics and technicians by the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that this bill will not result in a fiscal impact to the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR). This bill eliminates a voluntary certification program to which there are no applicants and no regulants. No individuals have applied for this voluntary certification since the legislature established the program in 2014. An advisory board was formed but does not meet. DPOR has incurred no costs and brought in no revenue associated with this program.
