4. Title: Department of Environmental Quality; public comment.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of Environmental Quality to afford interested persons, for any nonemergency, nonexempt regulatory action, an opportunity, for at least 60 days, to (i) submit data, views, and arguments, either orally or in writing, to the Department and (ii) be accompanied by and represented by counsel or other representative.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: HB/SB30, as introduced, provides \$2.7 million from the general fund to support 18 positions and contract work to support environmental justice and outreach efforts. It is anticipated that this funding is sufficient to address any fiscal impact on the Department of Environmental Quality as a result of this bill.
