**4. Title:** Annual mixed beverage performing arts facility license

**5. Summary:** The proposed bill permits the Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority to issue a mixed beverage performing arts facility license to persons operating food concessions at any corporate and performing arts facility in Fairfax County, provided that the corporate and performing arts facility is (i) occupied under a bona fide long-term lease management or concession agreement, the original term of the which was more than one year and (ii) has a total capacity in excess of 1,400 patrons. The license authorizes the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption in Board approved areas on dates of performances or events.
