- 4. Title: Ignition interlock for first offense driving under the influence of drugs.
- **5. Summary:** The proposed bill provides that a court of proper jurisdiction may, as a condition of a restricted license, prohibit an offender from operating a motor vehicle that is not equipped with a functioning, certified ignition interlock system for a first offense driving under the influence of drugs. Under current law, such prohibition is required to be ordered as a condition of a restricted license.
