4. Title: Provision of mental health services to a minor; access to health records.

5. Summary: Prohibits a health care provider from refusing to provide mental health services to a minor on the basis that the parents of such minor refuse to agree to limit their access to such minor's health care records or request that such health care provider testify in a court proceeding regarding the treatment of the minor.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The legislation is likely to generate a relatively small number of such complaints, and the caseload could be handled within the existing budget of the Department of Health Professions and its boards.
