4. Title: Department of General Services; public posting of contract information.

5. Summary: Provides for the Department of General Services to post on its central electronic procurement system awarded contracts and any modifications to such contracts. The bill also provides that any contract awarded pursuant to an Invitation to Bid or Request for Proposals on or after July 1, 2021, including any subsequent modifications to the contract by a using agency as defined in Â§ 2.2-1110, shall be posted on the Department of General Services" central electronic procurement system. Additionally, a modification made by a using agency on or after July1, 2021, to any other contract awarded before that date shall be posted on the Department of General Services" central electronic procurement system, along with the original contract and any previous modifications.
