8. Fiscal Implications: Per the Code of Virginia, the Governor is required to submit legislation each year to update the state's Six-Year Capital Outlay Plan. The plan was last updated through legislation approved by the 2017 General Assembly.

The introduced bill included capital projects for which planning had either been previously authorized by the General Assembly but no construction funding had been provided, or projects being proposed for planning by the Governor in his introduced budget. The enrolled version of this bill modifies the projects listed to better coincide with the budget approved by the General Assembly.

Projects included in this legislation are not guaranteed to be funded for construction in the future or approved in the final 2020-2022 biennial budget. Thus, there are no immediate or direct fiscal implications as a result of this legislation.
