5.	<b>Summary:</b> The substitute bill provides that every individual who applies for or requests community or institutional long-term care services and supports as defined in the state plan for medical assistance services may choose to receive services in a community or institutional setting. Further, individuals may choose the setting and provider of long-term care services and supports from a list of approved providers. The bill also changes requirements related to the performance of such long-term care services and supports screenings. The bill requires the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) to report information related screenings on August 1 of each year.
