Every law-enforcement officer as defined in § 9.1-101 who is on duty and in uniform shall wear a 13 badge, nameplate, or other device that conspicuously displays the officer's badge or other identification 14 15 number or the name of the officer. Upon request for identification from any person, a law-enforcement 16 officer who is on duty and in uniform shall disclose his badge or other identification number or his 17 name. B. Any law-enforcement officer who is on duty and in uniform who intentionally obstructs or 18

conceals his badge or other identification number or his name is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.
