Emergency powers. 18 19 The Governor shall have the powers and duties related to states of emergency as provided by 20 general law, except that no declared state of emergency shall be in effect for more than seven days 21 unless approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to each house. During a 22 declared state of emergency, the constitutionally protected rights of all individuals shall not be
