10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 1 of Title 9.1 a section
12	numbered 9.1-116.7 as follows:
13	§ 9.1-116.7. Body-Worn Camera System Fund.
14	A. There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the
15	Body-Worn Camera System Fund, referred to in this section as "the Fund." The Fund shall be
16	established on the books of the Comptroller. All funds appropriated for such purpose and any gifts,
17	donations, grants, bequests, and other funds received on its behalf shall be paid into the state treasury
18	and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and be
19	credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal
20	year shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be
21	used solely for the purposes of assisting local law-enforcement agencies with the costs of purchasing,
22	operating, and maintaining body-worn camera systems as defined in § 15.2-1723.1. Expenditures and
23	disbursements from the Fund shall be made by the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the
24 25	Comptroller upon written request signed by the Director of the Department.
23	B. The Fund shall be administered by the Department, and the Department shall adopt guidelines to

and the function shall be duministered by the Department, and the Department shall daspr guadelines to
make funds available to local law-enforcement agencies for the purpose of assisting local
law-enforcement agencies with the costs of purchasing, operating, and maintaining body-worn camera
systems as defined in § 15.2-1723.1.
