3. Committee: Public Safety

4. Title: Law-enforcement officers; minimum qualifications.

5. Summary: Provides that any law enforcement officer in the Commonwealth who enters into the duties of such office shall not have been convicted of or pled guilty or no contest to any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, including but not limited to petit larceny, or any offense involving moral turpitude that would be a misdemeanor if committed in the Commonwealth, within the last three years. Current law prohibits any such convictions for law enforcement officers.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See below.

8. Fiscal Implications: Based on information received, the provisions of the proposed legislation is not expected to have fiscal impact on the state agencies with law enforcement personnel. According to the Compensation Board, the bill is not expected to have fiscal impact on Sheriff's office. The impact on local law enforcement agencies cannot be determined at this time.
