4. Title: Criminal Justices Services Board; Committee on Training.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation changes the membership of the Committee on Training by requiring that one member be an attorney representing the Virginia Indigent Defense Commission, one member be an attorney representing civil liberty groups, and one member be a mental health provider. The proposed legislation also specifies that the existing position allocated to a citizen member is for an individual who represents the community interests of minority individuals from one of the four groups defined in subsection F of § 2.2-4310. The proposed legislation reduces the representatives from the Virginia Sheriffs' Association and Virginia Association of Chiefs of Police from two representatives to one representative each and removes the representative designated by the Chairman of the Criminal Justices Services Board.
