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11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. § 1. That the Commissioner of Health, together with the Director of the Department of Environmental
13	Quality, shall convene a work group composed of representatives of the Department of Health appointed
14	by the Commissioner, representatives of the Department of Environmental Quality appointed by the
15	Director, and representatives of local governing bodies representing localities with land included in a
16	Resource Protection Area and such other stakeholders as the Commissioner and the Director shall deem
17	appropriate to develop a program to allow owners of septic systems located in portions of Resource
18	Protection Areas that are subject to recurrent flooding to add soil over the septic system tank and to the
19 20	septic system drainfield to improve septic system drainfield absorption and protect the public health and safety. In developing the program, the work group shall (i) review federal, state, and local laws,
20 21	regulations, and ordinances that prevent, prohibit, or restrict the addition of soil over a septic system
22	tank or to a septic system drainfield to improve septic system drainfield absorption and protect the
23	public health and safety identified by the workgroup participants prior to the first workgroup meeting;
24	(ii) identify any existing options for allowing owners of septic systems located in Resource Protection
25	Areas to add soil over the septic system tank and to the septic system drainfield to improve septic
26	system drainfield absorption and protect the public health and safety; and (iii) develop recommendations
27	for a permit program that would allow owners of septic systems that are appropriately located in
28	Resource Protection Areas that are prone to recurrent flooding to add soil over the septic system tank
29	and to the septic system drainfield to improve septic system drainfield absorption, including the
30 21	appropriate agency to administer the permit program, criteria necessary to obtain a permit, oversight
31 32	requirements, and any other requirements for such permit program. The work group shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the Chairmen of the House Committees on
3 <u>4</u> 33	Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources and Health, Welfare and Institutions and the Senate
33 34	Committees on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources and Education and Health by
35	December 1, 2020.
