## 11 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

12 1. That §§ 46.2-742.2, 46.2-745.1, and 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia are amended and 13 reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 46.2-725.3, 14 46.2-745.4, and 46.2-745.5 as follows:

14 46.2-745.4, and 46.2-745.5 as follows: 15 § 46.2-725.3. Special license plates for

§ 46.2-725.3. Special license plates for recipients of certain military decorations.

A. No special license plate for recipients of a military decoration shall be considered by the General
Assembly unless and until the person or entity seeking the authorization of such special plate has
demonstrated to the satisfaction of the General Assembly the order of precedence of such military
decoration as determined by the federal Department of Defense or other relevant federal agency.

20 B. Any special license plate for recipients of a military decoration falling below the Medal of Honor 21 and above the Purple Heart in order of precedence shall be authorized for issuance by the Department with a \$10 one-time fee in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates. Any special license 22 23 plate for recipients of a military decoration falling below the Purple Heart in the order of precedence 24 shall be authorized for issuance by the Department with a \$10 annual special license plate fee in 25 addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates. Special license plates for recipients of the Purple Heart shall be issued as provided in § 46.2-742. The Department is authorized to issue an additional 26 plate reflecting the "V" for Valor for any plate that the federal Department of Defense or other relevant 27 28 federal agency has determined is eligible for the "V" for Valor Device.

29 C. Notwithstanding § 46.2-725, special license plates for the recipients of a military decoration are
30 exempt from subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725. Unremarried surviving spouses of individuals
31 eligible to receive such special license plates are also authorized to receive such special license plates.

\$ 46.2-742.2. Special license plates for persons awarded the Navy Cross, the Distinguished
 Service Cross, the Air Force Cross, the Distinguished Flying Cross, or the Distinguished Flying
 Cross with a "V" for Valor.

On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Navy
 Cross, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Air Force Cross, or the Distinguished Flying Cross, or the
 Distinguished Flying Cross with a "V" for Valor, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special
 license plates.

**39** The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of subsection **B** of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 40 plates issued under this section.

41 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section42 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

The design of license plates issued under this section to persons who have been awarded multipledecorations shall reflect the number of such decorations.

For each set of license plates issued under this section the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

47 § 46.2-745.1. Special license plates for persons awarded the Navy and Marine Corps Medal, the
48 Airman's Medal, the Army Soldier's Medal, or the Coast Guard Medal.

49 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services of the United 50 States that the applicant has been awarded the Navy and Marine Corps Medal, the Airman's Medal, the 51 Army Soldier's Medal, or the Coast Guard Medal, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to such persons. No fee shall be charged for the issuance of these license plates under this section to any 52 53 one motor vehicle owned and used personally by any applicant. For each additional set of license plates issued to an applicant under this section, the Commissioner shall charge the prescribed fee for state 54 55 license plates. For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in 56 addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are

58 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and
59 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided
60 for.

61 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under 62 this section.

63 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section64 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

65 § 46.2-745.2. Special license plates for persons awarded the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal.
66 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services that the
67 applicant has been awarded the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the Commissioner shall issue
68 special license plates to such persons and to unremarried surviving spouses of such persons.

69 For each set of plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time an annual fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

71 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and 72 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided 73 for.

The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.

76 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section77 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

§ 46.2-745.4. Special license plates for persons awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, the Navy
 Distinguished Service Medal, the Marine Corps Distinguished Service Medal, or the Air Force
 Bo Distinguished Service Medal.

81 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services that the
82 applicant has been awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, the Navy Distinguished Service Medal, the
83 Marine Corps Distinguished Service Medal, or the Air Force Distinguished Service Medal, the
84 Commissioner shall issue special license plates to such persons.

85 For each set of plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the 86 prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

87 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and
88 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided
89 for.

**90** The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.

92 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section93 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

94 § 46.2-745.5. Special license plates for persons awarded the Defense Distinguished Service Medal 95 or the Defense Superior Service Medal.

96 On receipt of an application and written confirmation from one of the armed services that the
97 applicant has been awarded the Defense Distinguished Service Medal or the Defense Superior Service
98 Medal, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to such persons.

99 For each set of plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the100 prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

101 It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a person described in this section to willfully and 102 falsely represent himself as having the qualifications to obtain the special license plates herein provided 103 for.

**104** The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under **105** this section.

106 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section107 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

108 2. That all license plates issued pursuant to § 46.2-745.1 or 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia prior

109 to July 1, 2021, shall remain valid until their expiration and shall be renewed under the provisions

110 of § 46.2-745.1 or 46.2-745.2 of the Code of Virginia as they existed prior to July 1, 2021.
