9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. The Board of Education shall amend the definition of "traumatic brain injury" in 8VAC20-81-10
11	to read as follows:
12	"Traumatic brain injury" means an acquired injury to the brain caused by an external physical force
13	or by other medical conditions, including stroke, anoxia, infectious disease, aneurysm, brain tumors, and
14 15	neurological insults resulting from medical or surgical treatments, resulting in total or partial functional
15 16	disability or psychosocial impairment, or both, that adversely affects a child's educational performance. Traumatic brain injury applies to open or closed head injuries resulting in impairments in one or more
17	areas, such as cognition; language; memory; attention; reasoning; abstract thinking; judgment;
18	problem-solving; sensory, perceptual, and motor abilities; psychosocial behavior; physical functions;
10	protein sorving, sensory, perceptian, and motor abundes, psychosocial behavior, physical janeticis,

19 information processing; and speech. Traumatic brain injury does not apply to brain injuries that are 20 congenital or degenerative, or to brain injuries induced by birth trauma. (34 CFR 300.8(c)(12)).
