10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 40.1-29.1 as follows:
12	§ 40.1-29.1. Disclosure of terms of employment.
13	A. Every employer shall furnish to each employee, at the time of the employee's hiring, a written
14	disclosure that shows:
15	1. The name of the employee;
16	2. The name of the employer, in addition to any trade name or assumed name under which the
17	employer conducts business in the Commonwealth;
18	3. The street address and phone number of the employer's main office or principal location;
19 20	4. The rate of pay and basis thereof, whether paid by the hour, shift, day, week, salary, piece,
20 21	commission, or other basis, including overtime rate of pay;
<sup>21</sup> 22	5. For employees paid a piece rate, the applicable piece rate of pay and the number of pieces completed at each piece rate; and
$\frac{12}{23}$	6. The regular payday established by the employer as required by subdivision A 1 of § 40.1-29.
24	B. Every employer shall notify its employees in writing of any changes to the information set forth in
25	subsection A at least seven calendar days prior to the time of such changes.
