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10	WHEREAS, national service includes participation in programs such AmeriCorps, Senior Corps, and
11	other similar programs and initiatives, as well as participation in military service; and
12	WHEREAS, participants in national service programs receive hands-on work experience, valuable
13	networking opportunities, and professional skills training; and
14	WHEREAS, participants in national service programs are paid and can also receive assistance with
15	education expenses through access to education awards granted by such programs; and
16 17	WHEREAS, participants in national service help address both emerging and persistent community
17	needs in areas such as education, health and human needs, public safety, disaster preparedness and response, environmental stewardship, and veterans' assistance; and
19	WHEREAS, participation in national service provides innumerable benefits to both the participants
20	and the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Department of Social
22	Services be requested to study ways to increase participation in national service.
23	In conducting its study, the Department of Social Services shall consider (i) promoting participation
24	in national service via advertising of service opportunities through social media and traditional media
25	outlets, (ii) identifying ways to increase funding for service opportunities, (iii) creating a Secretary of
26 27	Service position within the Governor's Cabinet to advise the Governor and other members of his Cabinet
27 28	on strategies to integrate national service opportunities into state initiatives and programming, (iv) strengthening hiring preferences in state government for individuals who have completed a year of
20 29	service in a national service program, (v) offering retirement service credits for individuals who have
3 0	completed a year of service in a national service program, (v) providing in-state tuition for those
31	serving in national service programs in the Commonwealth, and (vii) identifying other strategies for
32	increasing participation in national service.
33	Technical assistance shall be provided to the Department of Social Services by the Virginia Office of
34	Volunteerism and Community Service, the Governor's Advisory Board on Service and Volunteerism, the
35	Virginia Board of Workforce Development, the Chief Workforce Development Advisor, and the
36	Department of Military Affairs. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the
37 38	Department of Social Services for this study, upon request. The Department of Social Services shall complete its meetings by November 30, 2021, and shall
30 39	submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report of its findings
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41	and recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive summary and report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated
