5 WHEREAS, Edwin Eagle of Staunton received the 2020 Distinguished Service Award from the
7 Virginia Golf Course Superintendents Association for his outstanding contributions to golf course
8 management; and

9 WHEREAS, Edwin "Ed" Eagle began to cultivate his love of golf at a young age, when his family
10 relocated near Gypsy Hill Golf Club of Staunton; he helped clean and maintain the course, leading to a
11 part-time job that grew into a managerial position and 17 years of employment; and

12 WHEREAS, while working at Gypsy Hill, Ed Eagle earned a bachelor's degree from Mary Baldwin 13 University and a master's degree from the University of Pittsburgh; he mostly taught himself the golf 14 course management trade, studying in the winter and applying what he learned to the course in the 15 spring and summer; and

16 WHEREAS, after graduate school, Ed Eagle worked as superintendent of Ingleside Golf Club for 26
17 years; in the 1990s he joined the Shenandoah Valley Turfgrass Association and served terms as a board
18 member, vice president, and president during his long tenure; and

19 WHEREAS, Ed Eagle earned a designation as a certified golf course superintendent in 2001 and
20 offered his leadership and expertise to the newly formed Virginia Golf Course Superintendents
21 Association (VGCSA); and

WHEREAS, as a member of the VGCSA board, Ed Eagle completed several significant projects, a
 best management practices manual, a nutrient management planning program, and a water management
 plan during a major drought; and

WHEREAS, respected and admired by his peers, Ed Eagle has been a trusted mentor and friend to
 numerous colleagues and has strengthened the VGCSA and the field of golf course management in the
 Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it

 29 commend Edwin Eagle on receiving the 2020 Distinguished Service Award from the Virginia Golf
