9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. That the Board of Medicine shall amend its regulations to require that patients be notified that
11	they have the right to opt out of the presence of a chaperone during medical examinations, provided
12	that the chaperone is medically unnecessary. The regulations shall also include a provision permitting
13	health care practitioners to refuse to perform medical services for a patient who refuses the presence of
14	a chaperone.
