10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 54.1-3931 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 54.1-3931. Granting certificates without examination; law professors.
13	A. The Supreme Court shall have discretion to grant a certificate without examination to any attorney
14	who has been admitted to practice law before the court of last resort of any state or territory of the
15	United States or the District of Columbia for at least five years. The certificate shall entitle the holder,
16	after paying his license tax, to practice in the courts of this the Commonwealth.
17	B. The Supreme Court shall have discretion to grant a certificate without examination to any
18	attorney who has (i) been admitted to practice law before the court of last resort of any state or
19	territory of the United States or the District of Columbia for at least two years; (ii) made at least six
20	pro hac vice appearances in a court in the Commonwealth, whether state or federal; and (iii) obtained
21	a juris doctor or LL.M. degree from an accredited law school in the United States that was approved by
22	the American Bar Association at the time of the attorney's graduation. The certificate shall entitle the
23 24	holder, after paying his license tax, to practice in the courts of the Commonwealth.
24 25	C. The Supreme Court shall also have discretion to grant a certificate without examination to any person connected with any foreign embassy or legation to appear in the courts of this the
23 26	Commonwealth in all matters connected with his official duties, provided that the person has been
2 7	admitted to practice in the court of last resort of the jurisdiction of the embassy or legation to which he
28	is attached or he has received a degree from a law school approved by the American Bar Association.
2 9	C. D. The Supreme Court shall have the authority to promulgate rules and regulations allowing
30	professors in law schools located in the Commonwealth, which are accredited by the American Bar
31	Association, to become associate members of the Virginia State Bar. Nothing in this subsection shall
32	preclude the granting of a certificate without examination to a professor who is otherwise eligible for

 Association, to become associate memoers of the virgina state bar. Nothing in this subsection sharp preclude the granting of a certificate without examination to a professor who is otherwise eligible for such a certificate under any other provision of this section.
D. E. The Supreme Court may authorize the Board or any committee thereof to administer the provisions of this section. 35

E. F. All other persons shall take the examinations and comply with the applicable provisions of this chapter.
