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11 12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 53.1-5 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 1 of Title 53.1 a section numbered 53.1-7.1 as
13 14	follows:
15	§ 53.1-5. Powers and duties of Board.
16	The Board shall have the following powers and duties:
17	1. To develop and establish operational and fiscal standards governing the operation of local,
18	regional, and community correctional facilities;
19	2. To advise the Governor and Director on matters relating to corrections;
20	3. To make, adopt, and promulgate such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the
21	provisions of this title and other laws of the Commonwealth pertaining to local, regional, and
22	community correctional facilities;
23	4. To ensure the development of programs to educate citizens and elicit public support for the
24	activities of the Department;
25	5. To develop and implement policies and procedures for the review of the death of any inmate that
26 27	the Board determines warrants review that occurs in any local, regional, or community correctional facility. Such policies and proceedures shall incorrecte the Board's authority under § 52.1.6 to ansure the
27 28	facility. Such policies and procedures shall incorporate the Board's authority under § 53.1-6 to ensure the production of evidence necessary to conduct a thorough review of any such death;
20 29	6. To establish minimum standards for health care services, including medical, dental,
3 0	pharmaceutical, and behavioral health services, in local, regional, and community correctional facilities
31	and procedures for enforcing such minimum standards, with the advice of and guidance from the
32	Commissioner of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services and State Health Commissioner or their
33	designees. Such minimum standards shall require that each local, regional, and community correctional
34	facility submit a standardized quarterly continuous quality improvement report documenting the delivery
35	of health care services, along with any improvements made to those services, to the Board. The Board
36	shall make such reports available to the public on its website. The Board may determine that any local,
37	regional, or community correctional facility that is accredited by the American Correctional Association
38 39	or National Commission on Correctional Health Care meets such minimum standards solely on the basis
40	of such facility's accreditation status; however, without exception, the requirement that each local, regional, and community correctional facility submit a standardized quarterly continuous quality
41	improvement report to the Board shall be a mandatory minimum standard; and
42	7. To report annually on or before December 1 to the General Assembly and the Governor on the
43	results of the inspections and audits of local, regional, or community correctional facilities conducted
44	pursuant to § 53.1-68 and the reviews of the deaths of inmates that occur in any local, regional, or
45	community correctional facility conducted pursuant to § 53.1-69.1. The report shall include (i) a
46	summary of the results of such inspections, audits, and reviews, including any trends identified by such
47	inspections, audits, and reviews and the frequency of violations of each standard established for local,
48	regional, or community correctional facilities, and (ii) any recommendations for changes to the standards
49 50	established for local, regional, or community correctional facilities or the policies and procedures for
50 51	conducting reviews of the death of inmates to improve the operations, safety, and security of local, regional or community correctional facilities:

54	9. To review and comment on all budgets and requests for appropriations for the Department prior

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INTRODUCED

The Board may authorize the payment of medical expenses incurred by a prisoner after his release or discharge from the Department when such expenses are the result of an injury suffered by the prisoner while incarcerated and not caused by the misconduct of the prisoner. 59 60

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
