3. Committee: Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

4. Title: Historic resources; acquisition and lease of land.

5. Summary: Exempts additional land acquisition activities of the Department of Historic Resources (the Department) and the Board of Historic Resources (the Board) from review by the Department of General Services and authorizes the Department and Board to undertake additional leasing and property acquisition activities related to battlefield properties, designated landmarks, and other properties of historic significance.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not result in a fiscal impact to the Department of Historic Resources. Any additional work generated as a result of this legislation can be absorbed by current staff.
