3. Committee: Public Safety

4. Title: Concealed handgun permits; demonstration of competence; emergency.

5. Summary: Provides that any applicant who completed an online course to demonstrate competence with a handgun as required pursuant to §18.2-308.02(B) for the purposes of applying for a concealed handgun permit and contacted the circuit court clerk's office prior to January 1, 2021, but was prohibited from appearing in person at a circuit court clerk's office because of restrictions due to COVID-19 shall be eligible to apply for a concealed handgun permit through April 30, 2021. The bill contains an emergency clause.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8 below.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of State Police (VSP) administers the concealed weapons permitting process in the Commonwealth. According to VSP, the proposed legislation is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on agency operations. To the extent there is an impact on Circuit Court Clerks, it cannot be determined at this time.
