4. Title: Capital outlay plan.

5. Summary: Updates the six-year capital outlay plan for projects to be funded entirely or partially from general fund supported resources.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Per the Code of Virginia, the Governor is required to submit legislation each year to update the state's Six-Year Capital Outlay Plan. The plan was last updated through legislation approved by the 2020 General Assembly. The bill includes capital projects for which planning has either been previously authorized by the General Assembly but no construction funding has been provided, projects being proposed for planning by the Governor in his introduced budget, and projects included in the plan approved by the 2020 General Assembly. Projects included in this legislation are not guaranteed to be funded for construction in the future or approved in the final 2020-2022 amended biennial budget. Thus, there are no immediate or direct fiscal implications as a result of this legislation.
