**3. Committee:** Transportation

**4. Title:** Entry onto land for inspection for transportation purposes.

**5. Summary:** Requires the Commissioner of Highways to provide a landowner with 30 days' notice of the intent to enter and inspect property to ascertain suitability of the property for transportation purposes, and eliminates the requirement that the Commissioner first request permission to enter the property and then provide notice of intent to enter if permission is not granted. Requires the same such requirements of any locality or any petitioner exercising the power of eminent domain.
