CHAPTER 399

An Act to amend and reenact § 10.1-415 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Rappahannock State Scenic River.

[H 1819]

Approved March 30, 2021

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 10.1-415 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 10.1-415. Rappahannock State Scenic River.

The mainstem of the Rappahannock River in Rappahannock, Culpeper, Fauquier, Stafford, and Spotsylvania, *Caroline, King George, Westmoreland, Essex, and Richmond* Counties and the City of Fredericksburg from its headwaters near Chester Gap to the ~~Ferry Farm-Mayfield Bridge~~ *Essex-Middlesex and Richmond-Lancaster County lines*, a distance of approximately ~~86~~ 165 river miles, is hereby designated as the Rappahannock State Scenic River, a component of the Virginia Scenic Rivers System.
