6	A BILL to direct the Department of Taxation to analyze the prospect of establishing an online portal for
7	tax practitioners.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Department of Taxation shall, with input from affected stakeholders, analyze the
10	prospect of establishing an online portal for tax practitioners who possess a valid Power of Attorney
11	and Declaration of Representative form to access confidential client information. In its analysis, the
<b>12</b>	Department shall evaluate (i) comparable services offered by the Internal Revenue Service or by other
13	states that provide electronic access to confidential taxpayer information and (ii) cybersecurity concerns
14	associated with providing such services. The Department shall identify the estimated costs associated
