FLOOR AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

- 4 A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 32.1-42.2 and 44-146.17:1.1, relating to declaration of emergency; essential workers; access to personal protective equipment and immunization; emergency.
- 7 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 8 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 32.1-42.2 and 44-146.17:1.19 as follows:

10 § 32.1-42.2. Declared emergency; certain persons deemed essential workers; priority for personal 11 protective equipment and immunization.

In any case in which the Board or the Commissioner has made an emergency order or regulation to 12 13 meet an emergency, not provided for by general regulations, for the purpose of suppressing nuisances 14 dangerous to the public health or a communicable, contagious, or infectious disease or other danger to 15 the public life and health, funeral service licensees and any person employed by a funeral service establishment [, or by any public medical examination facility established under Article 1 (§ 32.1-277 et 16 seq.) of Chapter 8 of Title 32.1, ] shall be considered essential workers and shall be included in any 17 group afforded priority with regard to (i) access to personal protective equipment and (ii) 18 19 administration of any vaccination against such communicable disease of public health threat during 20 such emergency.

§ 44-146.17:1.1. Declared emergency; certain persons deemed essential workers; priority for
personal protective equipment and immunization.

In any case in which the Governor has declared a state of emergency related to a communicable disease of public health threat pursuant to § 44-146.17, funeral service licensees and any other person employed by a funeral service establishment [, or by any public medical examination facility established under Article 1 (§ 32.1-277 et seq.) of Chapter 8 of Title 32.1, ] shall be considered essential workers and shall be included in any group afforded priority with regard to (i) access to personal protective equipment and (ii) administration of any vaccination against such communicable disease of public health threat during such emergency.

30 2. That an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.
